I have received several telephone calls from individuals interested in helping on committees. I haven't forgotten you and am still trying to determine what positions


need to be filled and what all is needed.

PROPOSAL

2007 Standing Rule Changes January 4, 2007

TO BE VOTED ON BY GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MONDAY FEB 5th, 7:30 PM VFW

- •Post-draft replacement of players will be made based on equal performance to the extent possible. Draft eligibility will be determined based on the system of 9 priorities, modified with 10th priority being 4th league player, 11th being 5th league player and 12th being 6th league player.
- •Managers, co-managers, and assistant managers may be determined prior to and allowed to participate in the draft. Co-managers and assistant managers must be assigned appropriate draft slots.
- •Delete 24 hour advance notice requirement. Players may have legitimate reason (sudden illness, family emergency, transportation problem, etc.) to miss games without being able to provide 24-hour notice.
- •Eliminate requirement for a life member to have attended (all) general membership meetings for past 5 years.
- •The Board may add additional items at its meeting February 5th.
